Mid Sussex District Plan Examination

The provisional agenda for the Mid Sussex District Plan hearing, commencing Tuesday 25 July, 10:00am, is as follows.

- 1. Whether MSDC16 contains an appropriate approach to the subject of unmet need in the Northern West Sussex HMA having regard to:
 - a. The timing of the step up (2024/25 proposed) and quantum post 2024/25;
 - b. Trajectory scenarios including future provision within the whole HMA;
 - c. The reasons for not meeting the totality of unmet need in Mid Sussex, ie "transport and habitats considerations at the required level of supply";
 - d. The practical implications of the shortfall in 2029/30.
- 2. The 5 year housing land supply position based on the identified OAN (discussion should be based on a submitted SoCG).
- 3. Whether the proposed modification to Policy DP5: Housing is sound in respect of the numbers of dwellings attached to settlements.
- 4. The effect on Ashdown Forest having regard to the Council's most recent work (evidence from the Council to follow shortly).

Two days have been allowed for this hearing. It is hoped that Items 1 and 2 at least will be dealt with on Day 1, but the position will be reviewed when SoCGs and statements are received.

Further submissions from participants will be accepted on the following terms:

<u>Submissions from the Developers' Forum, the other housing participants and public bodies</u> should be in the form of statements of common ground with the Council, and where there are differences, these should be tabulated and explained. Statements of any other kind are not encouraged.

<u>Submissions from local groups and individual participants</u> may be in the form of a short statement with a maximum of 2 sides of A4 covering all the issues.

The hearing will only relate to the Council's new material and will not go over old ground, and the same will apply to any SoCG or statement. Any submission not following these rules will be returned. SoCGs and statements should be submitted by 7 July 2017.
