Please note that the Local Land Charges Register migrated to HM Land Registry's central digital register on 21.03.22. Any LLC1 or Personal Search requests should go directly to HM Land Registry via their website – <https://www.gov.uk/search-local-land-charges>

Con29 Information from non-public registers can be obtained directly from the Local Land Charges section, which will act as a 'one-stop shop'. The section will provide responses on behalf of the Council's contributing departments. Searchers will be charged accordingly.

All such requests should be made via our online forms - <https://www.midsussex.gov.uk/planning-building/local-land-charges/> - and paid for with a credit or debit card.

Any Environmental Information Regulation (EIR) requests should be directed to the Freedom of Information (FOI) Officer - [foi@midsussex.gov.uk](mailto:foi@midsussex.gov.uk) - and a charge may be payable.
