Mid Sussex District Council Annual Infrastructure Funding Statement For Section 106

Reporting Period: From 01 April 2021 to 31 March 2022

Introduction

About this Statement

This is the Mid Sussex District Council Infrastructure Funding Statement (IFS) 2021/22 which has been prepared in line with legislative requirements. This statement provides an overview of the developer contributions <u>secured</u>, <u>received</u>, <u>allocated</u> and <u>spent by the</u> <u>Council</u> between 1st April 2021 and 31st March 2022.

Mid Sussex District Council secures planning obligations in consultation with other infrastructure providers, including West Sussex County Council. For the purpose of receiving and managing (i.e. spending the funds and overseeing the delivery of the related infrastructure) contributions, responsibilities are set out below:

Mid Sussex being party to all Section 106 agreements, all monies secured as a result of a planning permission being granted by the Council during the reported year will be detailed within this report. However, with regard to contributions received, allocated and spent, the IFS relates exclusively to funds under the responsibility of the Council. Information on matters such as transport, highways or education can be found with the <u>West Sussex</u> County Council Infrastructure Funding Statement.

The information presented in this report is the most robust information available at the time of publication. Therefore, although accurate at the point of publication, it may be subject to change.

Definitions

Through this report, there will be references to the following terms:

- **Secured:** A contribution that has been agreed within a signed legal document. These contributions have not been collected and if the planning application is not implemented, they will never be received and the associated projects will not be delivered alongside the development in question.
- **Received:** A contribution was paid or delivered in line with the signed legal document. Each contribution within section 106 agreements is subject to its own trigger (usually determined by the construction or occupation of a number of units). As a result, the collection of funds, and the subsequent delivery of infrastructure, may occur a number of years after the contribution was secured.
- Allocated: Monetary contribution was received and funds were earmarked to a specific project in line with the legal agreement. It will be specified where funds have

been committed by the Council (i.e. subject to a formal decision) and ready for release.

- **Spent:** Contribution was transferred following the production of invoices. The project is underway and will soon be delivered.
- **Financial year:** Unless stated otherwise it refers to the reported year, which for this IFS goes from 1 April 2021 to the 31 March 2022

Section 106 Matters

Community Infrastructure Levy Regulations (2019 Amendment) Regulation 121A Schedule 2 Section 3

a) The total amount of money to be provided under (i.e secured) any planning obligations which were entered during the reported year is £4,152,744.26. This figure does not consider indexation (inflation/deflation) that may be applied when the money becomes due.

This covers all funds secured via section 106 agreement as a result of planning permissions being granted by the Council. Part of this money may be paid directly to and managed by West Sussex County Council. This includes contributions secured towards education, transport and highways.

It should be noted that obligations are formula-based as described within the <u>Development Infrastructure and Contributions Supplementary Planning Document</u>. Where outline planning permission is granted, the Council is often unable to calculate the amount that will become due until further information becomes known for the development through reserved matter application for example.

b) The total amount of money received from planning obligations during the reported year was £4,786,061.44.

This only includes funds collected by Mid Sussex District Council. Information on matter such as transport, highways or education can be found within the <u>West Sussex County</u> <u>Council Infrastructure Funding Statement</u>.

- c) The total amount of money received prior to the reported year that has not been allocated is £0.
- d) During the reported year the following non-monetary contributions have been agreed under planning obligations:

i) The total number of affordable housing units to be provided as on-site provision agreed under planning obligations is 216.

The total number of affordable housing units to be provided by S106 off site funding allocations made within the reported period is 2.

ii) There is a requirement for relevant authorities to report on education provision within the IFS. The relevant authority for education provision is West Sussex County

Council and therefore information on the matter is included with <u>their Infrastructure</u> <u>Funding Statement</u>.

e) The total amount of money from planning obligations allocated towards infrastructure during the reported year was £4,856,765.79. Of this amount £4,794,675.11 was not spent during the reported year.

f) The total amount of money from planning obligations spent during the reported year was £1,471,750.56. Of this amount £244,192.67 was spent by a third party on behalf of Mid Sussex District Council.

It includes: Affordable housing for rent; Discounted market sales housing; and other affordable routes to home ownership. Qualifying conditions for each of these routes is set out in the NPPF's glossary. Record the count of units not value. |
| Bonds (held or repaid to developers) | These include financial securities which will need to be paid at certain trigger points during the development. |
| Community Facilities | Community facilities can include the provision of buildings and spaces such as village halls, community centres, places of worship, meeting places and libraries. To avoid double counting, health and educational facilities should be recorded under their main categories. |
| Digital Infrastructure | This includes electronic communications networks, such as next generation mobile technology (such as 5G) and full fibre broadband connections. It also includes radio and electronic communications masts, and the sites for such installations. |
