<b>Completed Ownership Certificate and Agricultural Land Declaration</b> you should sign Certificate A if you (and spouse or partner) own the application site and providing there are no agricultural tenants on the land. <b>Design and Access Statement</b> – All major developments and Listed Building applications. Major applications are those that are creating a floor area of 1000sq m or greater, creation of more than 10 new dwellings, or has a site area of over 1ha. Applications in a Conservation Area of 1 new dwelling or greater or creating more than 100sq m floorspace. For further information see separate guidance.	<input type="checkbox"/>	
<b>Location Plan</b> which should be up to date and at a scale of 1:1250 for an urban area or 1:2500 for a rural area. The application site should be clearly marked in <b>red</b> and include all land necessary to carry out the development, including access from the public highway, car parking, etc. Any other land owned should be outlined in blue.	<input type="checkbox"/>	
<b>Block/Site Plan</b> (at a scale of 1:200 or 1:500) highlighting the proposed development in relation to the site boundaries and other existing buildings on the site. Any trees or public rights of way affected by the development should be shown, together with the proposed parking arrangements. Any new boundary walls or fencing proposed as part of the development.
