NOW THEREFORE the Council in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Article 4 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1973 HEREBY DIRECTS that permission granted by Article 3 of the said Order shall not apply in the areas shown coloured pink on the said plan to the said development

This Direction may be cited as the "MID SUSSEX (HANMINGDEN LANE, WEST HOATHLY) DIRECTION 1975"



Statement in support of the

Mid Sussex (Hammingden Lane, West Hoathly) Direction, 1975

- 1. The Direction is made by virtue of the provisions of Article 4 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order, 1973.
- 2. The Direction covers three areas of land fronting Hammingden Lane, West Hoathly, and shown coloured pink on the plan attached to the Direction.
- 3. The effect of the Direction is that the following development specified in Schedule 1 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order, 1973 shall not be carried out unless permission is granted on an application in that behalf:-

Class	Brief	Description of Development
II .	1.	Minor operations, including the erection of gates, fences, walls and other means of enclosure.
IV	2.	The use of land for any purpose on not more than 28 days in any one calendar year.
VI	1.	The erection of agricultural buildings, and works.
XX11		The use of the land as a caravan site.

- It is considered that the Direction should be made by reason of the location of the land.
 - (a) The land is situate in an area of great landscape value on the County Development Plan and has been included within the proposed High Weald area of outstanding natural beauty which, it is understood, is likely to be designated shortly by the Countryside Commission.
 - (b) The land is very prominent in the landscape as almost the whole of it falls away sharply on either side of Hammingden Lane, a ridge road, and is very exposed of view. This is in contrast to the land beyond to the North and South where the topography, including large areas of woodland, provides considerable screening effect.

5. The Cuckfield Rural District (Hammingden Lane, Cob Lane and Cinder Hill) Direction, 1973 is cancelled.
