I am an advisor, together with Matt Grist Director and Head of Transport Planning at Jubb Consulting Engineers Ltd and others, to Mr D J Peacock, Barredale Court, Turners Hill Road, East Grinstead, West Sussex RH19 4LX, a representor to the Mid Sussex District Plan 2015 Submission etc.

Mr Peacock has, over the last decade, made representations through his team of advisors on District and Local Area Plans and related matters. He has provided and Mr Grist has presented evidence on East Grinstead and Surrounds Traffic Network Conditions to the Examination of the recently made East Grinstead Neighbourhood Plan.

In providing evidence to the above, Mr Peacock has over the last two and half years and at his own considerable expense, commissioned Jubb Consulting Ltd to carry out in depth traffic surveys and reports on East Grinstead and the Surrounding Area. As a result, Jubb has built up considerable knowledge as to the state of the EG Traffic Network from the 14 days of surveys across the seasons of the severely congested A22 Junctions etc. which we believe would be of help to the Examination.

The resulting four Jubb reports, latest September 2016, provide a comprehensive area wide assessment of the East Grinstead (EG) Town Transport Network and key junctions on routes to the M23 and M25 Motorways. As they have become available these reports have been provided to local authorities and made publically available on web sites (East Grinstead Town Council, Google etc). They have also been taken into technical evidence by the West Sussex County Council for consideration of planning applications at EG. Recently they were referenced in a 12th January 2017 Felbridge appeal decision and the Surrey County Council Tandridge District Local Plan Strategic Highways Assessment Report.

Mr Peacock and his team have taken great interest in the discussions and progress of the Examination and with it now having reached the stage of reviewing the Constraints on Development in the District we wish to contribute to this review, in the form of the attached Jubb Consulting representation that considers the Impact of the Established East Grinstead Severe Traffic Constraints on the Mid Sussex District Council Strategic Land Availability Assessments (SHLAAs) Not Allocated in the District Plan or Neighbourhood Plans as outlined by MSDC 5.
