THE MID SUSSEX DISTRICT COUNCIL ((OFF STREET PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2006) (AMENDMENT NO. 1) ORDER 2018

Notice is hereby given that on 4th July 2018 the Mid Sussex District Council made an Order under the Provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose of regulating the use of Car Parks in the District of Mid Sussex. The Order comes into operation on 9th July 2018.

The general effect of the Order is i) to allow the flexibility in the types of payments accepted for the payment of charges to include pay by phone, website, mobile app system and credit or debit card in addition to allowing the use of virtual season tickets, ii) to permit only plug in electric/hybrid vehicles to use the reserved bays in the relevant car parks and iii) to add (and in one case to remove) small areas to the extent of some car parks.

A copy of the Order and associated maps, a copy of the Council's Statement of Reasons for making the Order and a copy of the Principal Order may be inspected during normal office hours at the Council Offices, Oaklands, Oaklands Road, Haywards Heath, RH16 1SS.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of this Order, or any provision contained therein, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Tradffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within 6 weeks from 4th July 2018 apply to the High Court for this purpose.
