Why people are being involved?
Mid Sussex District Council introduced a Taxi Licensing Policy on 1 st October 2012. This was reviewed and readopted in October 2017.
The Council has reviewed and amended the criminal convictions section of the policy. The full document can be read on this website.
The amendments were reviewed by the Scrutiny Committee Community, Housing and Planning on the 27 th June 2018

When will people be involved?

- **Public consultation on amendment scheduled July and August** (for eightweeks). There will be a public consultation for eight weeks in between 9th July and 27th August 2018 on the draft document.
- Amendments after the public consultation September 2018. A final draft, taking into account amendments from the consultation, will be presented to the Scrutiny Committee for Community, Housing and Planning for their approval before final approval by Full Council.
- Amendment agreed for adoption scheduled December 2018. It is anticipated that the amendments to the Taxi Licensing Policy will be presented to Council for adoption in December 2018.

How will people be involved?

The consultation will be open to all and we will seek to inform and receive comment from the widest possible range of the community. We will:

- Provide details and documentation on the Council's website.
- Letters or emails will be sent to all organisations listed in section 1 above¹.

What happens to the results?

The results from this consultation will be considered as part of a report to the Scrutiny Committee for Community, Housing and Planning on 21st November 2018.
