

Woodside Haywards Heath

Woodside is a picturesque development, where the houses and apartments are arranged in a network of leafy avenues, curving terraces and incidental open space which lead into more private mews and courts. Throughout, key buildings act as landmarks and introduce one neighbourhood to the next. The development has been further optimised through the clever use of split level housing which follow the natural contours of the site.

The architecture speaks the language of traditional Wealden buildings, using boarding and brickwork in a contemporary interpretation of this well-loved style. Woodside's homes have a distinctive identity, created by features such as gables, Juliet balconies, pitched roofs, projecting eaves, bay windows and porches. The gently sloping land allows for maximum sunlight and glimpses of history in views of the former hospital buildings, now restored, in the near distance.





The immediate surroundings are tranquil and green, with a central landscaped green, play areas for children, traffic calmed zones and a border of mature woodland. Parking is plentiful yet discreet, and cycle and pedestrian routes are integrated throughout the development.
