Monday 27 July	
Tuesday 28	<p><b>Sport</b>, this session will include 4 sporting challenges that need no equipment! Score yourselves and take part virtually alongside your friends and strive to be the very best that you can whilst having a go! We will show you how to set up the activities, play along with us and score yourselves, see if you beat your score! Don't forget a pen and paper</p> <p><b>Music Bus Songs</b> - Shaker/ pans to drum/ percussion instrument</p>
Wednesday 29	<p><b>Outdoor</b> – Bees and Butterflies</p> <p>For Bees - pine cones, yellow/black ribbon or wool, card, scissors! <a href="#">Bumble Bee Conservation</a>   <a href="#">Bee Friendly Plants</a></p> <p>For Butterflies - For the butterflies you will need pipe cleaners, beads and scraps of fabric. <a href="#">Big Butterfly Count – download chart</a></p>
Thursday 30	<p><b>Circus</b> –<b>Make your own Poi equipment</b>- long or short socks: balls or small bags of rice or pasta in a sandwich bag to go in sock or anything round will do</p>
Friday 31	<p><b>Tom Foolery</b></p> <p><b>Wastebuster Cadets - Make your pirate crafts ready for your next mission!</b></p> <p>Junior Wastebuster cadets - Make your pirate hat, telescope and pirate eye patch – 2 empty toilet/kitchen rolls, yoghurt pop or similar, ECO brown tape, safety scissors, crisp or snack packets with a shiny inside, coloured wrappers such as sweet wrappers, thin cardboard, small paint brush, container for mixing paint, black food colouring, small jug water, thick white paper/card, black felt tip pen</p> <p>Senior Wastebuster cadets - Make your own pirate ship and treasure island</p> <p><b>Sussex Green Living – Makers magic</b></p> <p>Preparation before watching the video, you will need the following. Please decide for yourself if your child can use blunt ended scissors or sharper scissor. And decide if your child or you should use the needle when making the beads and jewellery. The younger children will need to work with an adult, helping to select the magazine pages they want to use, they can help with drawing the lines and cutting, but an adult will need to carry out the rolling of the beads with the needle!</p> <p><u>To make paper beads for jewellery and keyring holder:</u> A read unwanted colourful magazine Ruler / Pencil / Blunt ended scissors / Glue stick / Needle / Thick sewing thread</p> <p><u>To make a magical milk carton bird:</u> Plastic milk carton of any size / Permanent marker pen Scissors (sharp scissor are required so an adult might need to help) Hole punch / String or cotton</p>
