Description:

I'm seeking to license the detached garage of my domestic property. All off sales of alcohol will be ordered remotely by the customer (by phone, email, online, etc). Customers will not attend the premises in person for collection or for any other purposes.

I'm seeking a premises license solely for the purposes of online and postal sales, to be delivered either by ourselves from the licensed premises, or by courier from the licensed premises.

The garage is detached but closely neighbouring our house in a quiet residential area. We have security lights and all doors to the garage remain locked (when not unloading). In early January 2021 (approx. the same period as we hope this licence to come into force), repair work is scheduled on the garage. Part of this work will entail the repair of the standard doorway on the north side of the garage (see attached plan and the label 'doorway'). We will then be able to use this doorway for access to the garage and avoid the need to use the 'up and over doors' that face the driveway, as these can be noisy. Our daily operating hours will not exceed 9am-9pm, so some level of noise will be tolerable, but despite this we know it's important to be as considerate as possible to our neighbours.

All forms of advertising and promotional literature detailing the delivery service (including internet sales and flyers/leaflets) will clearly state that a Challenge 25 policy is in place, the recommended forms of ID are accepted and that alcohol should only be purchased for delivery to intended recipients (or persons who will accept delivery on behalf of named recipient) who are aged over 18.

The person accepting the delivery must be aged 18 years or over. Where the person accepting delivery appears to be under 25, a recognised photographic ID must be produced prior to delivery. Failure to produce satisfactory age verification ID will result in the alcohol not being delivered and instead returned to the premises. All refusals will be documented in the refusals book.

All off sales of alcohol made via the alcohol delivery service will be made in sealed containers only. (In future, customers may provide their own bottles to the premises for filling with drink, in which case if the bottle is hand tightened after refilling it will comply with this condition.)

Alcohol deliveries will only be made to a residential, church, community hall or business address.

Customers ordering alcohol for delivery to a residential or business address will have their age verified on the site. All orders on the site will be recorded and retained for no less than 12 months and produced on request to an officer of a Responsible Authority.

All staff members engaged, or to be engaged in selling alcohol shall receive full training pertinent to the Licensing Act, specifically in regard to age-restricted sales, and the refusal of sales to persons believed to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs. Induction training will be completed prior to engaging in the sale of alcohol. Refresher training will be conducted thereafter at intervals of no more than 12 weeks. All restricted sales training undertaken by staff members shall be fully documented and signed by the employee and the DPS. All training records shall be made immediately available upon request to officers of a Responsible Authority.

For deliveries where the alcohol is delivered by a third party (likely to be APC Couriers), where the DPS has no direct supervision or control over the delivery and delivery is anticipated to take more than 24 hours:

- All forms of advertising and promotional literature detailing the delivery service (including internet sales and flyers/leaflets) will clearly state that that alcohol should only be purchased for delivery to intended recipients (or persons who will accept delivery on behalf of named recipient) who are aged over 18.
- In the event that the person ordering and paying for the alcohol nominates another person as the recipient of the alcohol (as a gift, etc), the person ordering and paying for the alcohol will be required to state as part of their order that the recipient is aged over 18.

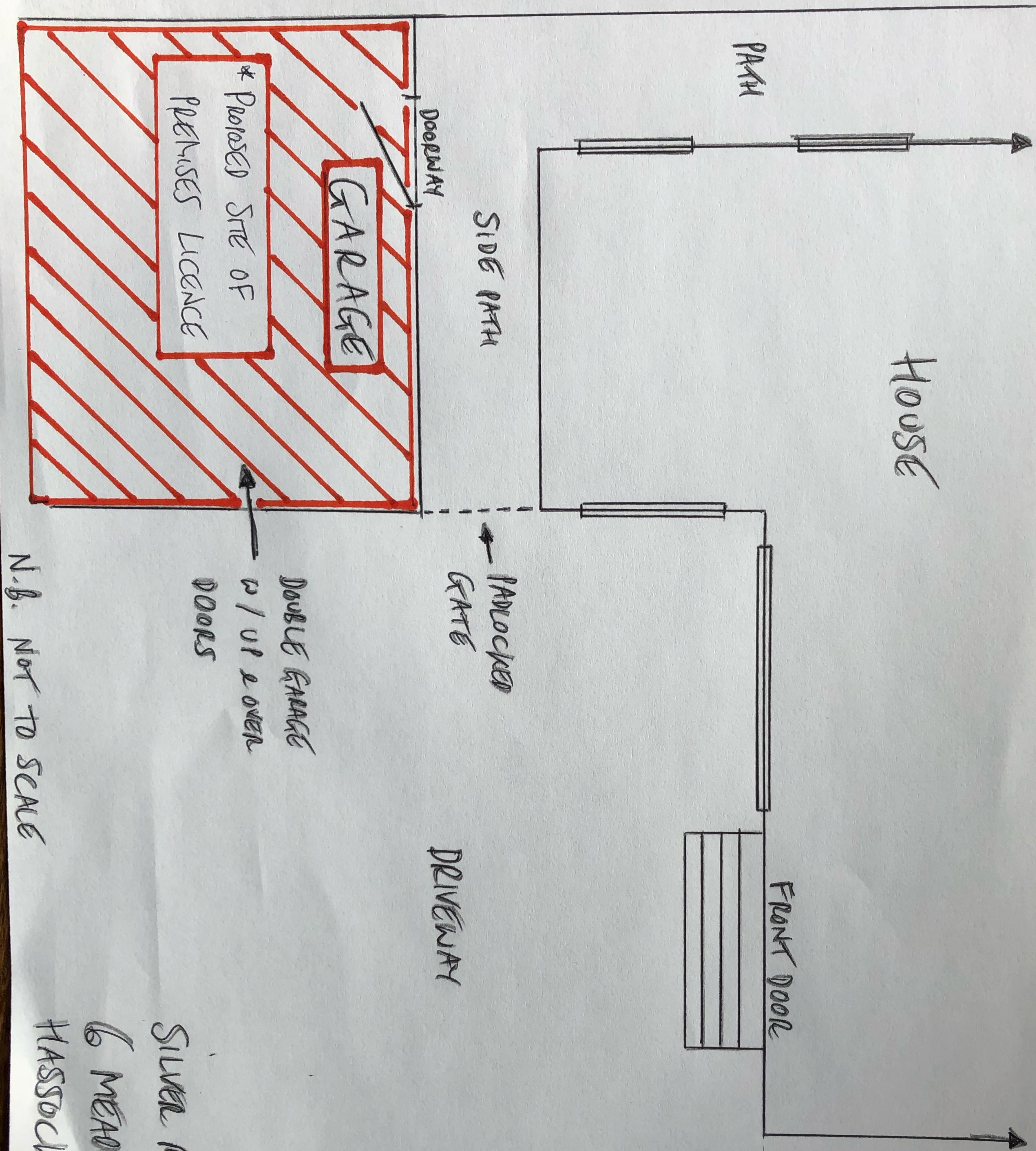

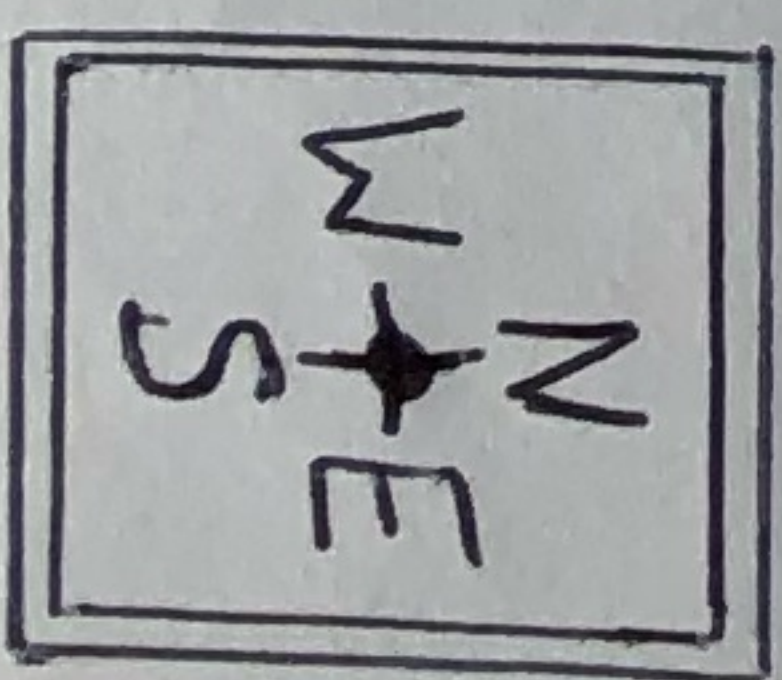
