**Notice of Submission of the Mid Sussex Site Allocations Development Plan  
Document and availability of submitted documentation**

Mid Sussex District Council has prepared a Site Allocations Development Plan Document (DPD) which it has submitted to the Secretary of State for independent examination. The Site Allocations DPD supports the strategic framework for development in Mid Sussex up to 2031 as set out in the Mid Sussex District Plan. It allocates employment and housing sites, as well as including five additional strategic policies.

Mid Sussex District Council has submitted the following documents to the Secretary of State in accordance with regulation 22 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) England Regulations 2012:

The availability of documents is in accordance with The Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) (Coronavirus) (Amendment) Regulations 2020.

The Site Allocations DPD will now be subjected to an independent examination to be conducted by the Planning Inspectorate. This is a continuous process running from the date of submission through to the receipt of the appointed Planning Inspector's Report. Part of this process will involve hearing sessions where those invited by the Planning Inspector to attend will have the opportunity to respond to matters raised by the appointed Planning Inspector. These hearing sessions are likely to take place in Winter-Spring 2021. Once confirmed, all details relating to the examination process will be advertised, made available online and sent to those people who asked to be notified of the examination.
