Our free clinical waste collection service includes the provision of clinical waste sacks and/or yellow sharps boxes for sharps such as epi-pens and diabetic syringes.

A free kerbside collection of small electrical items and household batteries with your normal rubbish collection. Visit our household small electricals webpage for further information.

We offer assisted collection services for residents who are physically unable to take out their rubbish, recycling and garden waste to the boundary of their property.
