I don't want to be part of the Public Inquiry but would welcome the opportunity to submit the following comment, I have received the notification and supported the application. Mid Sussex have refused a much needed community asset and prevented a development that should clearly be permitted. In addition MSDC have not provided any substantive evidence on why there is no need. The reports seem to show clear need and one report which is a transport analyst appointed by MSDC confirms that extra capacity is needed and this is in addition confirmed by the only crematorium expert report in relation to this application provided by a Peter Mitchell and has not been taken into account by the planning officer. Some of my clients have been distressed with the time taken to arrange funerals because of the lack of capacity and choice, covid has made this worse.

The whole matter has been appalling handled and no technical evidence has been presented to the contrary. Lastly it's got planning for a cemetery with an enormous chapel building.

As a local health professional MSDC seem to have acted unreasonably please ask the inspector to consider my comments
