AP14 - Matter 5.3: Policy SA34 Protection of existing employment sites.

Suggested Main Modification: After first paragraph, insert the following text

Development proposals outside the traditional employment uses classes for nonemployment generating uses will be supported on existing and allocated employment sites, if it is demonstrated that the continued use of a site, or its development for employment for employment uses, is not viable, through the provision of:

- (i) details of comprehensive marketing of the site for at least 12 months and appropriate to the prevailing market conditions; and
- (ii) a financial appraisal that demonstrates that the development of any employment generating use is unviable.

Development proposals outside the traditional employment uses classes for non-employment generating uses will be supported on existing and allocated employment sites, if it is demonstrated that the continued use of a site, or its development for employment for employment uses causes/or would lead to site-specific, environmental problems, such as noise, pollution of traffic generation, recognising the environmental benefits to be gained by redeveloping these sites for non-employment generating uses. non-employment uses in existing employment areas.
