Mid Sussex offer a range of household waste and recycling services



Garden waste

Subscribe to the garden waste collection service to get a kerbside collection, from a wheeled bin once a fortnight. This is a chargeable service paid annually by direct debit.



Bulky waste

Arrange for the collection of bulky and electrical waste, such as old furniture or large appliances from your home. This is a chargeable service per item.



Clinical waste

Our free clinical waste service is for the collection and disposal of healthcare waste and sharps that are hazardous or infectious as these should not be disposed of in your household rubbish bin.



Small electricals

A free kerbside collection of small electrical items and household batteries with your normal rubbish collection. Visit our household small electricals webpage for further information.



Assisted collection

We offer assisted collection services for residents who are physically unable to take out their rubbish, recycling and garden waste to the boundary of their property.
