Horsted Keynes Neighbourhood Development Plan

Details:

Horsted Keynes Parish Council has submitted its Neighbourhood Development Plan (NDP) to Mid Sussex District Council for independent Examination. The Plan Area covers the Horsted Keynes Parish which lies in the east of the district and contains the village of Horsted Keynes. The NDP includes policies on Housing (non-allocations), design, Local Green Spaces, employment, transport and parking. Once adopted, these policies will be used to determine planning applications locally along with the Mid Sussex District Plan.

Consultation on the Submission (Regulation 16) version of the Neighbourhood Plan is taking place from **Monday 26th September until 23:59 Monday 7th November 2022**. All representations received from this consultation will be forwarded to an independent Examiner appointed to examine the Neighbourhood Plan.
