<p>First Contact: CCB-E Form</p> <p>If a property is empty it will be sent a an A4 form with the letters 'CCB-E' in the top left-hand corner.</p> <p>This communication will be sent on or around the 27th July 2026.</p> <p>Please respond by no later than the 10th August 2026 to avoid receiving further communications from us.</p>	<p>Why have I received this? The property is currently listed as empty and we need to verify this information.</p> <p>Do I need to respond? This form will have the letters 'CF-E' in the top left-hand corner.

This communication will be sent on or around the **24th August 2026**.

Please respond by **no later than the 23rd October 2026** to avoid receiving further communications from us.

Why have I received this?

Do I need to respond?

Yes, whether there are changes or not – you must respond.
