Proxy Vote Application for a Definite or Indefinite Period for Overseas and Service Electors (includes Crown Servant, British Council and Armed Forces Electors and their Spouse/Civil Partners)	<p>This type of application will be used for overseas electors and those registered as service electors.</p> <p>Service electors are individuals who:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Are in the armed forces or the spouse/civil partner of an individual in the armed forces. • A crown servant or British Council employee or the spouse/civil partner of an individual in either Occupation. <p>Applicants can apply for a definite or indefinite period of validity.</p> <p>No further evidence is required to support this type of application.</p>	<p>Online</p> <p>Paper Application Form (Overseas Electors)</p> <p>Paper Application Form (Armed Forces Electors/Spouse or Civil Partners)</p> <p>Paper Application Form (Crown Servant or British Council Employees/Spouse or Civil Partners)</p>	Yes

Proxy Vote for a Definite or Indefinite Period due to Disability	<p>This type of application is available for individuals who:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cannot vote in person due to a disability. • Cannot vote in person as they have been detained in hospital under the civil sections of the Mental Health Act 1983. <p>This type of application requires support to evidence the need for such arrangement.</p> <p>Applicants can apply for a definite or indefinite period of validity.</p>	Paper Application Form	Yes
Proxy Vote for a Definite or Indefinite Period due to Employment	<p>This type of application is available for individuals whose:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Employment or their spouse or civil partner's employment means that they cannot vote in person. <p>This type of applications requires support to evidence the need for such arrangement. Applicants can apply for a definite or indefinite period of validity.</p>	Paper Application Form	Yes

Proxy Vote for a Definite or Indefinite Period due to Education	<p>This type of application is available for individuals who:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Will be attending an educational course which means they cannot vote in person, or; • Their spouse or civil partner will be attending an educational course which means they cannot vote in person. <p>This type of applications requires support to evidence the need for such arrangement.</p> <p>Applicants can apply for a definite or indefinite period of validity.</p>	Paper Application Form	Yes
