Describe the premises The venue is open farm land adjacent to the Bluebell Railway between Sheffield Park and Horstead Keynes with access from Sloop Lane. Comprising of open fields of approximately 90 acres. The show site has good vehicle access provided from local roads and the A272 at Scaynes Hill. There are natural fenced boundaries and fencing ensuring that the public are not able to gain access to the road, railway or adjacent fields. The steam rally will be on open grassed land and is of an undulating terrain. The event is organised by High Weald Steam Working Weekend Ltd. The main aim is to operate a traditional steam show. Some of the exhibitors will be staying of site from Thursday 12th through to Monday 16th with day exhibitors arriving early Saturday and Sunday Morning till close. The show is open to the public from 10am to 5pm on Saturday and Sunday. The Beer marquee will be open from 10am on Saturday and Sunday and will also be open in the evenings for exhibitors till 12 midnight on Friday and Saturday evening. Show finishes at 5pm on Sunday. The Beer marquee will have outside seating on benches with views of the railway and access to the show field allowing persons to watch and see the show. All drinks will be served in plastic reusable containers. The marquee will have adequate lighting with ample signage and emergency exits. The beer marquee will be run by Waterloo bonfire Society for the duration of the show.

The venue is open farm land adjacent to the Bluebell Railway between Sheffield Park and Horstead Keynes with access from Sloop Lane. The objective is to operate a steam heritage working weekend within the show field at Freshfields farm (Public Car Park, Show field, exhibitor camping). The show will consist of vintage road and agricultural steam engines, working exhibits, heavy haulage, traditional showman's fair, classic vehicles, auto jumble, trade stands, catering and a real ale marquee with nominal entertainment. The show is open to the public from 10am to 5pm on Saturday and Sunday and open in the evenings for exhibitors staying on site only from 6pm till 12 midnight. Waterloo Bonfire society will be in charge of the bar. Who will have a licenced DPS in charge and all staff (volunteers) will be WBS trained asking the over 25 rule. They will operate a a log book to record all questionable activities. During the day there will be ESP trained SIA's patrolling around the bar and show field with at least one SIA permanently on duty throughout the evening within the proximity of the bar. The bar will be in communication with the SIA and committee members with short range hand held radios.
