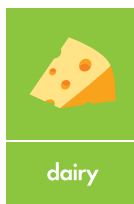
What can I put in my kitchen caddy?

No plastic packaging please!

Recycle all of your food waste, including the following:



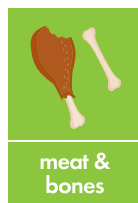
- ✓ All uneaten food and plate scrapings



- ✓ Dairy products
- ✓ Cheese
- ✓ Eggs



- ✓ Bread
- ✓ Cakes
- ✓ Pastries



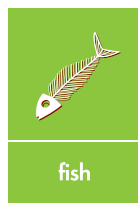
- ✓ Raw meat
- ✓ Cooked meat
- ✓ Bones



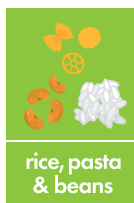
- ✓ Tea bags
- ✓ Coffee grounds



- ✓ Whole fruit
- ✓ Stones and pips
- ✓ Fruit skins and peel
- ✓ Raw and cooked vegetables
- ✓ Vegetable peelings



- ✓ Fish
- ✓ Cooked fish
- ✓ Bones



- ✓ Rice
- ✓ Pasta
- ✓ Beans

You can even scrape uneaten food straight into your caddy.

Please do not put any of these materials in your food waste caddy:

- ✗ Packaging of any kind
- ✗ Liquids such as milk, oil or liquid fat
- ✗ Any material that is not food waste

Remember to recycle your food waste, no matter how little. All food waste is turned into energy, and compost-like material.

Clean, Dry and Loose

- Coffee cups and lids

- Clean takeaway containers
- Foil trays
- Tin foil



glass bottles & jars

- Wine bottles
- Beer bottles
- Perfume bottles
- Jam jars
- Sauce jars

- Shredded paper
- Paper towels
- Tissues
- Polystyrene cups

- Pet food pouches
- Food pouches
- Crisp packets

- Pyrex®
- Drinking glasses and crockery



metal cans & aerosols

- Food cans
- Drink cans
- Pet food cans
- Empty aerosols
- Biscuit and sweet tins

- Cables
- Batteries
- Electrical items



cartons

- Fruit juice cartons
- Custard cartons
- Soup cartons
- Milk cartons

- Plastic bags and film
- Polystyrene



plastic bottles & containers

- Milk/drinks bottles
- Bathroom/laundry bottles and tubs
- Moulded plastic packaging
- Flexible toothpaste tubes
- Food, fruit and ready meal pots, tubs and trays
- Plastic container lids
- Non-black plastic plant pots and seed trays (over 40mm x 40mm)

- Squash your empty plastic bottles and then replace the lid
