Proxy Vote Application for a Specific Election or Referendum	This type of application is available to all electors. It will be valid for one election/referendum only. You must provide a reason as to why you are applying for a proxy vote. e.g: • Education • Employment • Occupation • Service	Online Paper Application Form	Yes
Proxy Vote Application for a Definite or Indefinite Period for Overseas and Service Electors (includes Crown Servant, British Council and Armed Forces Electors and their Spouse/Civil Partners)	This type of application will be used for overseas electors and those registered as service electors. Service electors are individuals who: • Are in the armed forces or the spouse/civil partner of an individual in the armed forces. • A crown servant or British Council employee or the spouse/civil partner of an individual in either Occupation. Applicants can apply for a definite or indefinite period of validity. No further evidence is required to support this type of application. Postal Proxy Application	If your nominated proxy cannot get to your polling station on polling day, they can apply to vote by post as a postal proxy. They will follow the same application process as a regular postal voter, however – this type of application can only be completed via a paper application form. Type of Proxy Vote	Description / Validity	How to Apply (Please Click to Apply)	National Insurance Number required?
Proxy Vote for a Definite or Indefinite Period due to Disability	This type of application is available for individuals who: • Cannot vote in person due to a disability. • Cannot vote in person as they have been detained in hospital under the civil sections of the Mental Health Act 1983. This type of application requires support to evidence the need for such arrangement. Applicants can apply for a definite or indefinite period of validity.	Paper Application Form	Yes
Proxy Vote for a Definite or Indefinite Period due to Employment	This type of application is available for individuals whose: • Employment or their spouse or civil partner's employment means that they cannot vote in person. This type of applications requires support to evidence the need for such arrangement. Applicants can apply for a definite or indefinite period of validity.	Paper Application Form	Yes

Proxy Vote for a Definite or Indefinite Period due to Education	This type of application is available for individuals who: • Will be attending an educational course which means they cannot vote in person, or; • Their spouse or civil partner will be attending an educational course which means they cannot vote in person. This type of applications requires support to evidence the need for such arrangement. Applicants can apply for a definite or indefinite period of validity.	Paper Application Form	Yes

Emergency Proxy Votes	If you have an emergency that means you cannot go to the polling station in-person, you can apply for an emergency proxy up to 5pm on polling day.
